# 49 MARKET VINTAGE ARTISTRY EVERYWHERE ULTIMATE PAGE KIT



#### TOOLS REQUIRED:

Paper Trimmer, Double-Sided Tape or Glue, Craft Knife and Scissors. Optional: Foam Tape & Sanding Tool.

PREPARATION: Carefully remove all the laser cut pieces and printed chipboard from the packaging. Using a craft knife, turn to the reverse of the sheet and carefully cut the "pins" or nodules off each of the pieces. Sand off any residue of the nodules to leave a smooth edge.

Tip: Look at the finished piece image - if pieces won't show, you can trim back unseen portion of laser cuts to use elsewhere.

## PAGE #1



Begin by assembling the various pieces shown. The bow and two blue clips will be found in the trinket bag. Frame, title, compass and enamel sign are on the chipboard sheet. All other pieces are from the laser cut elements.



Start to assemble and adhere pieces together. Add chicken wire behind the chipboard frame. Follow with the leafy stem on left and diagonal stripe across. Next add one of the blue frames at a tilt. Add lace on top and title.



Adhere the second blue frame on the right side of cluster follow by the map ephemera piece. Add two instamatic frames with photos behind.



Photo above shows the two stamps, enamel sign, buttons and word strip.

Finish by adding the additional bits. Large image to the right shows finished layout.

Use the orange cord to create a small bow. Clip over the stamps. Add the binoculars, compass and tiny blue button on top right.





# Page #2



Begin by assembling the various pieces shown. The bow, clip and tiny blue button will be found in the trinket bag. Large sphere, title, geo frame, arrow, instamatic frame and orange banner are on the chipboard sheet. All other pieces are from the laser cut elements.




Photo above shows the photo cluster - place the file tabbed piece on top of the orange mat placed down earlier so the orange and blue ticket show to the right. Next add Instamatic frame with photo behind. Chipboard title on top. Add the orange word banner with blue clip.

Finish by adding the additional bits. As done on previous layout, use the orange cord to create a small bow. Add chipboard arrow and buttons.





Start to assemble and adhere pieces together. Adhere the large sphere on to background paper. Add the ticket, word strip and geo frame to the left. The blue floral can be added on right (note you won't see the left hand side of it - can trim and use on another project).




Add the stamp frame with photo behind, orange remnant and blue ticket.




### Page #3




Begin by assembling the various pieces shown. The two distressed instamatic frames, compass, slide frame, G and O are on the chipboard sheet. All other pieces are from the laser cut elements.



Start to assemble and adhere pieces together. The photo reel and leafy vine behind the map remnant piece. Note - you can trim the leafy vine on the right side to use later.




Next, add photos behind the two instamatic chipboard frames. Add on top of the map remnant with the pink label in top.



Add the blue label holder, pink ticket, compass and the slide frame with photo behind.

Finish by adding the #GO, globe and blue laser cut bow.



Add the three torn notebook pieces as well as three laser cut frames with photo behind.




Photo above shows the added blue labels to the bottom part of photo frames as well as the title banner.

Finish by adding the additional bits. Three mini clusters are created with the various pieces shown. Note the blue buttons can be from chipboard sheet or the actual buttons in trinket bag.
